## 2010 Indian Lake Fireworks FUNd Ride

June 12, 2010

The Indian Lake Fireworks Fund Ride will be held on June 12, beginning at 8 a.m. from Old Field Beach. There are three different bicycle tours available. Check-in is 7:30 a.m.

The 15 mile ride begins from Old Field Beach, proceeds down S.R. 366 to the Five Parks area, on to Orchard Island and ends back at Old Field Beach.

The 30 mile ride begins from Old Field Beach, proceeds to the Five Parks area to Belle Center and ends at Old Field Beach.

The 60 mile rides begins from Old Field Beach, proceeds to Huntsville; to Riverside School and ends at Old Field Beach.

The price is \$25 for riders 13 and over and \$15 for ages 6 - 12. The cost includes a T-shirt with pre-registration. Ages 5 and under are free (no T-shirt.) Also included in the cost is SAG support (from 8-2 or last bike in), picnic at the end of the ride, and door prizes. Non-riders are also welcome to enjoy a picnic lunch for \$10.00. Left-over T-Shirts can be purchased for \$12.00.

If you prefer not to ride, there are other activities to enjoy at Indian Lake - walk the bike path, fish, boat, swim or just relax on the beach.

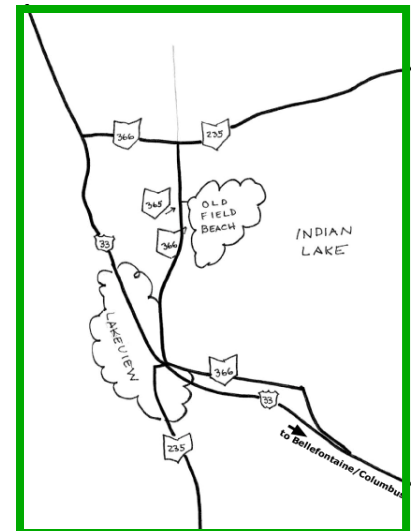

# Indian Lake's Got Talent

The Indian Lake Area Chamber of Commerce announced today that auditions will start soon for the annual search for the most talented person at Indian Lake.

The contest, sponsored by Duff's Quarry and venues listed below, is open to participants from 12 and up. There are two contest divisions: Youth (age 12-17) and Adult (age 18 and over). Prizes will be given at each audition with awards and cash prizes to the first three winners during the finals at the Beach Spectacular and Fireworks on July 3, 2010.

Even though most people prefer to perform individually, the contest will be open to participate as a couple talent. Participants can sing, dance, or perform any respectable talent. Most contestants are vocalists, but if you have a special talent that doesn't involve singing, we encourage you to participate. Those using foul language will be disqualified. Winners within the past three years can not participate.

One contestant from both age groups will advance to the finals from each venue. If a contestant doesn't win at one venue, he or she can audition at another. We encourage you to start early if you plan to be a finalist on the beach July 3.

Cash prizes will be awarded as follows: Adult Division: 1st place - \$300; 2nd place - \$150; and 3rd place - \$50. Youth Division: 1st place - \$150; 2nd place - \$75; and 3rd place - \$25.
