The *Parrots of the Caribbean*, a Dayton, Ohio band will open the party at 1 p.m. followed by The *Danger Brothers* from Columbus at 4 p.m. This will be the fifth year the *Danger Brothers* have performed at the Party at the Beach at Indian Lake.
