Putt Around the Lake Golf Outing

Participating Establishment Responsibilities

1. Construct a miniature golf hole inside or outside of your establishment. The hole can be of any design. The only two requirements are there must be some type of border to determine out-of-bounds and the ball must drop into a 4" hole. You must have golf hole ready for review 3 days prior to August 13; a committee will be testing your golf hole.
2. Promote and solicit teams to participate! Word-of-mouth to your customers is the best advertising! Collect the entry fees. Your establishment must sign up at least 5 teams. The more teams the better for everyone!
3. Furnish volunteers to act as scorekeeper/judge the day of the event. You need someone to announce the team to play and one team on deck, plus a scorekeeper/judge to keep the score. Teams need to move through the hole in 5 minutes or less. Teams need to keep moving to avoid backups. Example: 75 teams = 300 players...75 teams at 5 minutes is 6-1/4 hours. There were 181 teams last year.
4. It is your option to furnish snacks, but please give prizes for "holes-in ones" or any other creative marketing prize. Don't forget about the traveling trophy for the most creative decorative golf hole.
5. Your announcer will call each team up to the hole. The team will surrender their score card to your scorekeeper for score keeping. At the completion of the round the scorekeeper returns the card to the team and they move on to the next establishment. If your establishment is the last hole, the scorekeeper keeps the card and calls the 3 lowest team scores into "golf central" (Pam Miller - 937-441-9441). Please do this between 7-8 p.m. If there is no answer, leave your scores on the voice mail. **DO NOT CALL THE CHAMBER.**

Please make sure that every form has the phone number of at least one person that we can contact. Make sure each team picks a starting establishment. If too many teams opt to begin play at the same establishment we may have to move some teams to different starting locations.
